Dr. Jacek Majewski is a Professor in the Department of Human Genetics, at McGill University in Montreal, Canada. He received his BSc in Physics and MSc in Electrical Engineering from Stanford University. He obtained his PhD in Microbial Genetics from Wesleyan University, in 1998, a time at which the sequencing of the human genome was nearing completion. The combination of quantitative and biological training proved to be advantageous in the emerging field of genomics, and following post-doctoral research in human genetics at the Rockefeller University in New York, he established his own independent laboratory at McGill in 2005. He is now using genomics and computational approaches to identify the genetic causes of hereditary disease and cancer and to understand their downstream consequences.
